## OUR JUDGES

### ■ Karen Moore (NSWCFA)

I am a foundation member of the Rex Cat Club and have been breeding and showing cats for the past 29 years under the prefix **Euphoria**. Commencing with Burmese, which is still my main breed today, I have also had extensive experience in breeding Siamese, Orientals and Foreign White cats, winning 8 NSW Cat of The Year Awards with these breeds. Devon Rex are still part of my household and breeding program. I have imported both Burmese and Devon Rex from the UK to supplement the Australian bloodlines.



I am an International All Shorthair Judge and I am also a qualified Tutor Judge in all Shorthair Breeds with NSW Cat Fanciers' Association. I am a Life Member of the Oriental Cat Club of NSW, member of the Bengal Cat Club, Siamese & Shorthair Cat Club and The St. George Cat Club and I am a Patron of the Alpine Shorthair Cat Club of New Zealand.

I hold a degree in Psychology from the University of New South Wales and work as a Marketing Communications Manager.

### ■ Rhondda Watson (NSWCFA)

I am an All Breeds Tutor Judge and have helped with the training of many NSW and interstate Judges. I have judged throughout Australia and New Zealand where I have made many friends throughout the Cat Fancy. I enjoy my judging assignments and consider it a great privilege to be invited to judge and handle so many beautiful felines and such a variety of breeds in Australia & overseas.



The first pedigreed cats I owned were two neutered pet Chinchillas which I learnt to groom & care for on a trial by error basis. In 1975 I purchased two Seal Point male kittens, Nikolas & Czar, which the breeder urged me to show. After winning two Best in Show awards with Nikolas I neutered Czar, purchased a Seal Point female and started breeding my Sucheng Siamese. Since then I have bred many Seal Point & Blue Point kittens and have imported cats carrying famous UK & NZ bloodlines to improve my Siamese breeding stock.

I was President of the Siamese Cat Society for many years, resigning from that position in 1996 to become President of the Siamese & Shorthair Cat Club - a position I still currently hold. I have been a registered breeder since 1975. In 1984 I was

elected to the Consultative Committee of RAS Cat Control and have served on that Committee and its successor, the NSWCFA Management Committee, continuously since then. During these 23 years of service I have been involved with fund-raising & was responsible for organizing Cat of the Year Luncheons and Champion of Champion dinners for many years. I have also been involved in training classes for Shorthair Judges, Domestic Judges and Stewards. My goal is to see a United Australian Cat Fancy where all the controls work together to promote the breeding and showing of our pedigreed cats.

### ■ Peter Williams (GCCF)

Peter has owned Cornish Rex for the past 15 years and was chair of the Rex Cat Club in the UK for 11 years before moving to Melbourne with work. He was a member of the Joint Rex Breed Advisory Council for 8 years before taking the helm as a probationer judge and then promotion to a full judge. Peter is the owner of the Best Foreign desexed cat at the UK Supreme Cat show in 1998 - a lilac Bi-coloured Cornish Rex - Ch. & Gr Premier Baliqui Bintang Berekor. He is a previous GCCF Council Member & current Chairman of the Oriental Bi-Colour Group in the UK. Peter has a passion for both Cornish and Devon rex having been privileged to have bred Cornish from pure Cornish lines - Du-Bu & Amaska - descended from the original Cornish Rex. He comments: *I am delighted to have been asked to judge at your breed show. its a real privelege. I am looking forward to handling your Rex cats & hope that I can share my knowledge & experience from the UK with you.*



### ■ Valerie Harney (CFCCQ)

I have been an All Shorthair / Semi longhair judge since 1976 and an All-Breeds Judge since 1987. Throughout each year since attaining my licences, I have travelled throughout Australia and in several overseas locations including Malaysia, Japan and the United States. I am also on the All Breeds Guest Judges Panel of ACFA USA.



I have held many positions on committees throughout the years, including Minute's Secretary, Secretary and Chairperson. I have also been secretary and vice president of various clubs and until recently, I have show-managed several shows each year. I just adore being with Cat People talking 'Cat' and sharing the world wide love of the cat with all who care to listen. The introduction of the 'Australian Open Judging' method brought great joy to me as a judge because it allowed exhibitors, show personnel and the general public to share the judging of the cat.

All **Golden Oldie** exhibits will be benched amongst the youngsters in catalogue order.

A tribute section in the catalogue will promote these special exhibits, and will contain photos and room for a description of their career. **Please provide a photo and details with your entry**

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- An official NSW C.F.A. entry form must be completed and forwarded. *A form accompanies this schedule.*
  - As indicated on the form, for each exhibit entered a legible copy of the exhibit's 4 generation pedigree, as issued by a recognised controlling body, must be attached.
  - The **summary sheet** which accompanies this schedule must be completed and forwarded also.
- An exhibitor resident in NSW must be a current financial member of NSW C.F.A. Inc. However
  - A new exhibitor resident in NSW may show three times as a non-member provided any exhibit(s) shown is/are registered in the exhibitor's name with NSW C.F.A. Inc.
- An exhibitor resident in another state/territory/country must be a member of a recognised controlling body in that state/territory/country and the exhibit(s) entered registered in the exhibitor's name with that controlling body.
- Amendments to Title/Sex/Colour:** Any change to the title, sex or colour/pattern of an exhibit after an entry has been lodged must be submitted to the Show Secretary together with a copy of the amended Certificate of Registration
- Each kitten exhibit must be vaccinated.** Exhibitors must produce documentary evidence (valid vaccination certificate) for each kitten and a vaccination shall have been carried out not less than 14 days prior to the date of the show.
- Veterinary Inspection.** Each exhibit must be inspected by and pass the Veterinary Officer's inspection before being allowed to be benched in the show. Exhibitors are to handle their own exhibits at the vetting table.
- All exhibits must have all claws clipped
- It is a condition of entry that all cats/kittens remain on exhibition in show cages until 4.00 p.m..**
- The Show Entry Clerk reserves the right to transfer exhibits which are incorrectly entered.
- Returned Cheques:** Should any cheque forwarded in payment be returned unpaid, a money order, a bank cheque, or cash will be required to be forwarded immediately to ensure acceptance of entry. Any costs incurred by the Club in such a circumstance shall be paid by the exhibitor before the entry is processed.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the venue.
- Aggressive Exhibits:**  
A Judge or Steward does not have to handle any exhibit showing signs of aggression. Owners have a duty of care not to bench exhibits with a reported history of fractious behaviour. Show Managers and the Show Committee, in consultation with the Show Representative, have the right to require the removal of the latter exhibits from the Show.
- Cancellations** We ask for your co-operation in notifying the Show Secretary of cancellations before 12.00 noon on the Friday prior to the show (where possible).
- Awards:** Challenge, Best in Section & Best of Breed ribbons will be placed on cages as judging proceeds. Award Cards and Trophies will be placed on cages once all judging is concluded. **All such items placed on cages are the responsibility of the exhibitor and will not be replaced should they go missing. NOTE that as the Show is a Specialist Show no CCCA awards will be made.**
